Senator Ivana Bacik: Gender InJustice: Getting Women into Power

Reid Professor of Criminal Law, Criminology and Penology at Trinity College Dublin. She is a Labour Senator for Dublin University, a Senior Lecturer and Fellow of Trinity College (elected in 2005), and a practising barrister. She has written and published extensively on criminal law, human rights, constitutional law and related matters, and has a long track record of campaigning on civil liberties, human rights and feminist issues.

Professor Rosemary Hunter: Feminist Judgments and Feminist Judging

Professor of Law, University of Kent. She is the Academic Editor of *Feminist Legal Studies*, an Executive member of the Equal Justices Initiative, and has been Chair of the international Working Group on Gender and Law. Her research focuses on feminist and socio-legal themes, and she has published a number of articles on women lawyers, women judges and feminist judging. Together with Professor Clare McGlynn and Dr Erika Rackley, she was one of the organisers of the Feminist Judgments Project.

Professor Clare McGlynn: Rape Trials, Women and Judging

Professor of Law at Durham University and co-organiser of the Feminist Judgments Project. She is the author of *The Woman Lawyer: Making the Difference* and co-editor of *Rethinking Rape Law: International and Comparative Perspectives*.
